



ATTENTION PARENTS!

How to help your third grader be successful

- 1.) Check and sign his/her green book **every night**.
- 2.) Make sure your child is completing his/her homework. *Many times third graders are not yet independent enough to manage homework by themselves.*
Typical third grade homework is:
 1. Read from the STAR folder 20 minutes every night (the entire year).
 2. Math practice sheet
 3. Work that was unfinished in class

*Homework will be marked with a ("H/W" or "Tarea" next to the assignment)
- 3.) Write down how many minutes your child read in the STAR folder.
- 4.) Read the school newsletters.
- 5.) Communicate your questions/concerns with your child's teacher via the following options:
 - a. Email (preferred)
 - b. Green book
- 6.) Practice math facts with your child at home. Most students cannot master their multiplication and division facts *without* parent involvement; therefore, we need your help!
