

ATTENTION PARENTS!

How to help your third grader be successful

- **1.)** Check and sign his/her green book **<u>every night.</u>**
- 2.) Make sure your child is completing his/her homework. Many times third graders are not yet independent enough to manage homework by themselves.

Typical third grade homework is:

- 1. Read from the STAR folder 20 minutes every night (the entire year).
- 2. Math practice sheet
- 3. Work that was unfinished in class

*Homework will be marked with a ("H/W" or "Tarea" next to the assignment)

- **3.)** Write down how many minutes your child read in the STAR folder.
- **4.)** Read the school newsletters.
- **5.)** Communicate your questions/concerns with your child's teacher via the following options:
 - a. Email (preferred)
 - b. Green book
- **6.)** Practice math facts with your child at home. Most students cannot master their multiplication and division facts *without* parent involvement; therefore, we need your help!
